Purpose:	To place players in a division best suited to their ability. In doing so, all children have the opportunity to progress in the sport, playing the game at their level.		

INTRODUCTION

Rosebud Heart Soccer Club Inc. is a community club that aims to give all players a fair go, the opportunity to play to the best of their ability and to be good sports.

The aim of the Rosebud Heart Soccer Club Inc. Grading Policy is to place players in a division best suited to their ability. In doing so, all children have the opportunity to progress in the sport, playing the game at their level. Playing a competitive team sport teaches children lessons which they can use throughout all aspects of their life including persistence, team play, friendship and fair play. Playing within their ability also provides the opportunity for players to extend their friendship circle and meet others within the local community brought together by their love of playing soccer.

POLICY

It is a policy of Rosebud Heart Soccer Club Inc. that Junior Teams 12's and above be graded into divisions according to their ability.

Football Federation Victoria (FFV) Competitions

FFV competitions for Sub-Juniors consist of three different categories:

1. Kangaroos
2. Wallabies
3. Joeys

NB: Sub-Juniors **DO NOT** play for points and there is **NO** ladder – teams are placed in FFV categories according to ability.

FFV competitions from U12's and above are graded competitions with a ladder playing for points. In order to provide critical preparation for the upcoming season, grading will be conducted at the earliest possible time to provide coaches and players ample preparation before the season begins to secure the team.

The placement of teams into FFV categories is at the discretion of the Director of Coaching**.

**** In lieu of a Director of Coaching, the Committee will make decisions along with an independent, suitably qualified coach not affiliated with the club.**

Team Selection for Sub-Juniors 11 and under

There will be preliminary sessions held for all sub-junior players (11 years of age and under) in which all players must attend their age-specified sessions. This provides equal opportunity for both current and existing players to be placed in a team.

Coaches in each age group will designate their team players; where intervention is required the Director of Coaching (or independent Coach/Committee) will make the decision.

Composition of Teams

Ideally each team is composed of field players + 3 substitute players.



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Grading Procedure for Age Group 12 and Above

There will be preliminary grading sessions held for all players competing in the ladder competitions (12's and above) in which all players must attend.

The Coaches for each age group will run these preliminary grading sessions together, overseen by the Director of Coaching (or independent Coach/Committee). This provides equal opportunity for both new and existing players to be placed in a team based on the player's abilities.

Teams will be chosen by the Director of Coaching (or independent Coach/Committee) in consultation with the age group Coaches, according to competition division.

Finalised team selection will immediately be submitted to the Committee to be published.

NB: FFV assesses all ladder competitions and may re-evaluate and regrade teams as they deem required.

Composition of Teams

Each team will have a minimum of 12 players and a maximum of 14 (at the coaches' discretion).

Sub-Junior & Junior Players Playing Up

Any player wishing to play in an older age group will be provided the opportunity to do so provided the player displays the necessary skill level, maturity and ability to play in that age group.

The player will attend the grading sessions for that older age group. If the player is unsuccessful in displaying the necessary skill level, maturity and ability to play in the older age group they will return to their own age group.

Sub-Junior & Junior Players Playing Down

It is a requirement by the FFV that all players must play in their own age group or above. Please refer to the FFV policy for dispensation rules¹.

IMPLEMENTATION OF GRADING

Prior to preliminary grading sessions, a meeting with the Director of Coaching (or independent Coach/Committee) and all Coaches and Team Managers will be arranged to discuss the Grading Policy and its implementation as below:

- Three grading sessions will be arranged for each age group;
- The Director of Coaching (or independent Coach/Committee) will give the Coaches a list of skills they want to observe during the grading sessions;
- Coaches of each age group will run the grading sessions incorporating the skills given by the Director of Coaching (or independent Coach/Committee);
- The Director of Coaching (or independent Coach/Committee) will compile a list of players for each team in each age group. The lists will be discussed with Coaches and a final team list for each team in each age group will be produced and;
- Finalised team selection will immediately be submitted to the Committee to be published.
